Clothing for All

- Provided a full range of clothing to 989 households 2,920 bags of clothes were distributed to these households

Improving People's Health

- Our Dental Clinic served 494 patients
- 261 were provided with emergency extractions
- 233 received preventive care

Feeding the Needy

- Provided nourishing food to 2,109 households; food valued at \$218,852
- Distributed 4,197 bags of food, including 455 Thanksgiving meals

Warming the Cold

- Provided utility (including kerosene) assistance to 1,540 households; assistance valued at \$122,409.75

Program Goal:

Connect at-risk high school seniors with a program that promotes stability and health in their lives, with the practical goal of full-time employment upon graduation, representing a first career step in their lives.

The Youth Empowerment Program is built on the assumption that breaking the cycle of poverty is extraordinarily difficult and requires patience and time on the part of all.

- Weekly required meetings build relationships that are vital for program success.
- Monthly Saturday experiences provide windows to new possibilities and perspectives.
- And, an Outward Bound off-site team-building experience builds confidence and trust, leading to success.

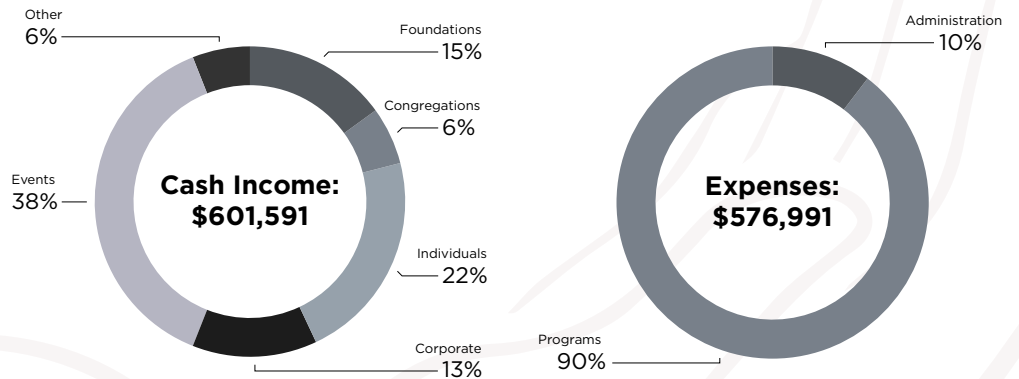
