Helping Hands offers HOPE, HELP, and CHANGE in Georgetown County. On faith-based principles, we seek to create sustainable futures through job training and youth empowerment to relieve generational and situational poverty, while meeting immediate needs of food insecurity, utility support, and dental care.

YOUTH EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM (YEP)

YEP is making an impact on our youth! Our goal is to prepare our students for a fluid future in the workplace and provide the skills to address challenges that face them in their future endeavors. We coach our YEP students by engaging them in real-world activities that are fun, yet challenging, such as zip-lining, escape rooms, and kayaking. Our YEP staff uses the Kikori SEL platform to build empathy, increase self-awareness and create connections in any learning environment. From weekly sessions to monthly activities, our YEP students build relationships, self-esteem and confidence they never knew they had within them.

Helping Hands of Georgetown Dental Clinic provides free examinations, cleanings, basic restorative needs and as a last resort, extractions for eligible neighbors. The clinic is open to afford those less fortunate the access to prevent and, where necessary, alleviate the pain and health risk associated with dental decay and/or lack of ongoing dental care. The support of our dental clinic through community partnerships and local dentists in the area along with individual donors and foundation grants has led to an increase in access to dental care, therefore leading to overall improvement in oral health.





